

# Residency Curriculum

## Residency Program Highlights

- Unique opportunity to train with diverse populations in multiple settings – Urban setting at a Level 1 trauma center at Grant Medical Center, Community-based setting at Doctors Hospital, and University setting at The Ohio State University.
- Osteopathic recognition with comprehensive clinical osteopathic training.
- Intensive four-year OBGYN ultrasound curriculum with CLEAR certification as PGY-1.
- Annual clinical anatomy review course with cadaver dissection.
- Comprehensive clinics. Including General OBGYN, Maternal Fetal Medicine, Urogynecology, Gynecologic Oncology, Mature Women, Addiction, OMM, Colposcopy, Breast, and REI.
- Extensive surgical exposure focusing on laparoscopic, robotic, and vaginal surgeries with a formal DaVinci robotic training curriculum.
- State-of-the-art simulation lab with laparoscopy, hysteroscopy, ultrasound, advanced patient simulation, and DaVinci robotic training.
- Faculty Mentorship Program - Family-like environment with dedicated staff to encourage critical thinking, and the development of clinical and surgical skills. The paired mentorship will help residents navigate professional development, work-life balance, and placement after residency.
- Resident Mentorship Program – Residents helping residents optimize their training while navigating the challenges of residency.
- 100% (first time) board pass rate for over 15 years.
- 100% postgraduate placement (employment or fellowship). Fellowship placements in Maternal Fetal Medicine, REI, and Women’s Global Health.

## Didactics

- Protected education time:
  - Daily education, including group discussion of textbook chapter readings, practice bulletins, committee opinions, review of current evidence-based articles.
  - Formal three-hour block on Wednesday mornings – including Simulation lab, Mock Oral board preparation, Ultrasound training, Guest lectures, OMM Lab, Morbidity and Mortality conference, Clinical Case Review, Journal Club, Fetal Heart Rate tracing review, and Quality Assurance sessions.
